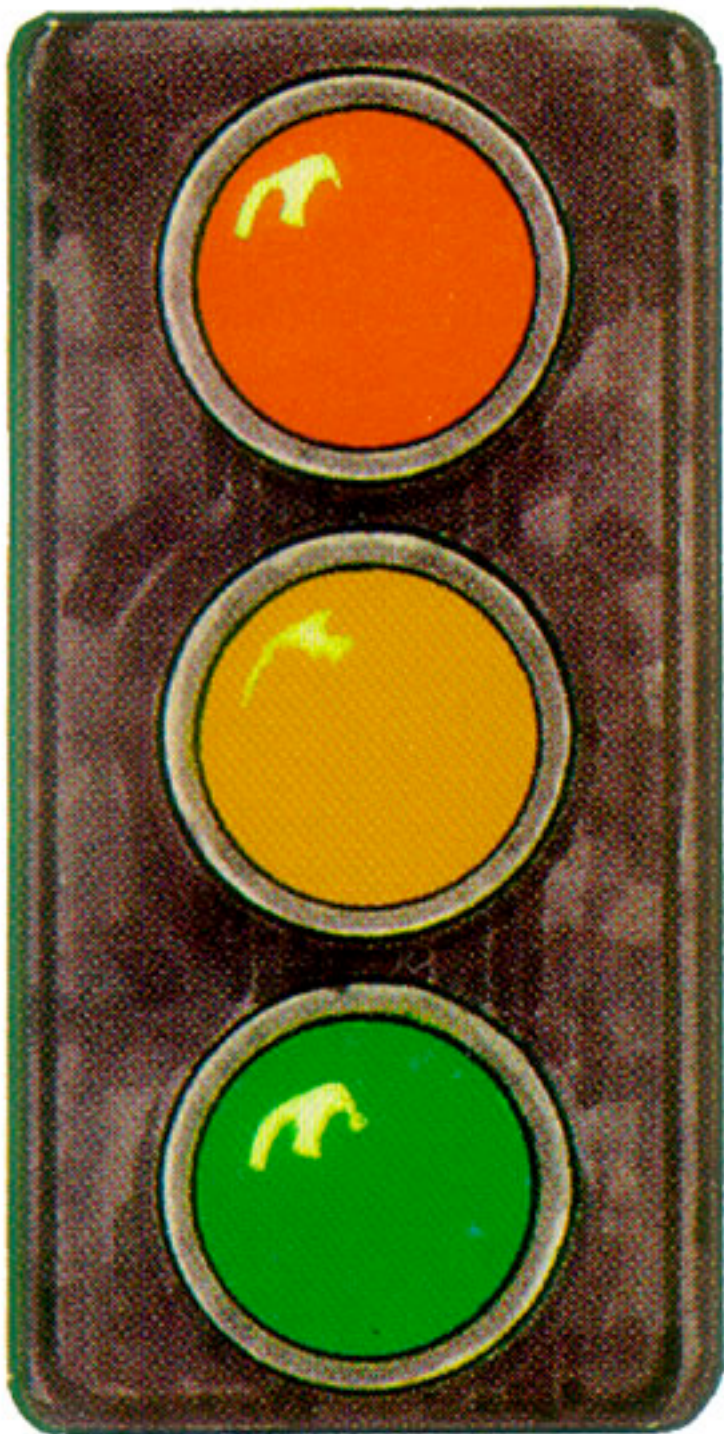


POSSIBLE

Wheelchair Push Zones



red

Adult only push zone

this might look like:

steep slope, narrow path, uneven ground, dangerous road crossing, near heavy traffic, unfamiliar public spaces

orange

Stage Three only push zone

this might look like:

moderate slope, normal paths, areas where younger children might find it difficult to control a chair, tighter spaces to manoeuvre through, marked pedestrian crossings

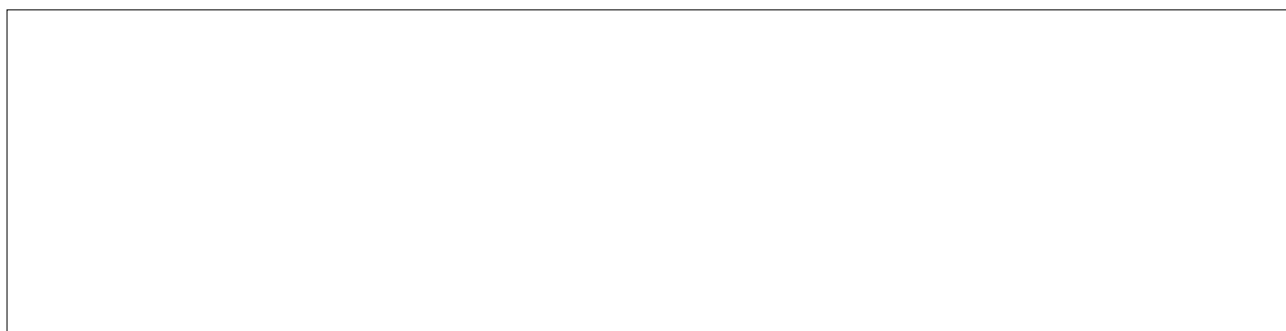
green

All licensee push zone

this might look like:

easy paths, flat spaces, sports grounds, COLA, inside classrooms, between classrooms

WHEELCHAIR ATTENDANT:

areas for learning



- understanding different chairs
- understanding preferences of different users
- braking systems
- safe parking (eg slopes, sun)
- pushing a safe distance from person in front
- able to see over top of person you are pushing
- chair & student not TOO HEAVY for person pushing
- understanding how a wheelchair is 'part of the body' of the wheelchair user
- getting permission from the wheelchair user they want to be pushed, they want to go where you suggest or asking what they want to do
- making sure everyone is safe
